

GENI: LOGO US AGE

The GENI logo has been developed to visually unify and coordinate all forms of communication.

The standards for usage are demonstrated on this page, so it is clear when to use a specific version of the logo for different applications.

2-Color Logo: 1 = PMS 152 (Orange) 2 = PMS Cool Gray 9 (Gray)



When to use 2-Color Logo:

This logo should always be used unless print limitations prohibit.

Example: 1-color print application

Exception: If used with 4-color printing, and can not add additional PMS colors, use CMYK version.

1-Color Logos: Process Black



When to use 1-Color Logos:

This logo should be used as an alternative to the 2-color PMS 152, and PMS Cool Gray 9 when applicable.

Example: Only when 1 color printing available.

Note: It should not be used with 4-color printing, signage or webpage display.

White (Reversed out) Logo:



When to use Reversed Logo:

This logo should be used when it needs to be knocked out of a field of solid color.

Note: Logo should never be knocked out on a photo or uneven field of color.

GENI: PROPER USE PRINT MEDIA


The GENI logo has been developed to provide the greatest visibility and harmony for it's elements. Never recreate, rescale, or rearrange its elements under any circumstance. Always use the master logos supplied with this manual.

Do not use the GENI logo if the detail and readability of the logo cannot be maintained.

To maximize the impact and visibility of the GENI logo when positioned alongside text or graphics, it should always be surrounded by a space margin. This margin is equal to height of the lowercase letters (x) and should be maintained above, below and to either side of the GENI logo. No words, symbols, or illustrative matter should intrude Into this area.

Do not use the GENI logo if the detail and readability of the logo cannot be maintained because of either the reproduction technique or the viewing distance (such as signage on buildings); or if there is insufficient space to reproduce it at the minimum size.

The minimum print size of the GENI logo should be 1". The minimum web size of the GENI logo should be 140px.



GENI: UNACCEPTABLE USAGE

Consistent and correct use of GENI is essential to protecting and maintaining our trademark rights. Examples of incorrect usage, which must be avoided, are shown on this page. Inconsistent application of GENI logo dilutes perceived brand quality, degrades brand awareness and is therefore unacceptable.



Do not shift the logo at any angle



Do not enclose the icon within a shape



Do not place a shadow or emboss on the logo



Do not arch the logo in any manner



Do not skew or distort the logo



Do not replace icons with clip art, or use clip art in conjunction with the logo






When to use Orange:

The GENI Orange is one of the core color of the brand logos. It should always be at 100% saturation when used as a type color.

Exception: This color may be used as a background or accent, the use of the color as a tint is also acceptable. It can also be used in conjunction with GENI Gray.

When to use Gray:

The GENI Gray is one of the core color of the brand logos. It should always be at 100% saturation when used as a type color.


Exception: This color may be used as a background or accent, the use of the color as a tint is also acceptable. It can also be used in conjunction with GENI Orange.
